Playstation4 MAC Address

Playstation 4 systems are able to access the Franklin Pierce network via wired or wireless connections. Before trying to setup your device for a wired connection, ensure that you have an ethernet cord connecting your Playstation 4 to the data port located in your dorm room.

If you are going to connect your Playstation via wireless connection, you will need to register the device via the Guest Management portal. Follow the instructions below to retrieve the MAC address necessary to complete the registration process.

- 1. Turn on your Playstation 4 without any disk in the drive and wait for the menu to pop up.
- 2. Navigate to the "Settings" icon (located on the far left).



3. Select the "System" icon under the Settings menu.
