Eduroam

eduroam is a worldwide service for providing wireless Internet access at institutes of education and science and their employees and students.

In order to use eduroam, an eduroam compatible device and a valid account with one of the participating institutions are required. The Franklin Pierce University accounts are valid for use with eduroam.

The eduroam wireless network use a combination of local resources as well as partner institution resources to provide authentication of users, as well as implements an encrypted radio connection (WPA2) and thus is also the recommended alternative for supported visitors to the University.
